MISSION

To create, systemize and disseminate the proper Physical Education knowledge through education, research and extension.

VISION

To remain as a national reference and to extend the international insertion in Physical Education, with a political-pedagogical project engaged in an effective participation in the social development.

HISTORICAL

The Physical Education Faculty of the State University of Campinas- UNICAMP was idealized by a group of professors in 1984 from the former Technical Assistance of the Rectorate for Physical Education and Sports - ATREFE, with the purpose of studying and doing research in the area, stimulating the education of professionals able to create, criticize and elaborate new proposals, thus changing the course of Physical Education in Brazil.

The Physical Education undergraduate course was created in 1985, as a Bachelor degree program in Sportive Techniques. The FEF was the first institution in the country to offer a Bachelor degree program in the area, anticipating Resolution 003/87 of the Ministry of Education and Culture (MEC). In 1986, the Physical Education Faculty started to offer courses of specialization, aiming to bring the graduated professionals up to date. In 1988, when the first class was graduating, the Masters Degree Program was created. In 1992, identifying the high demand for the undergraduate course and recognition in the national scenario as one of the main institutions of the area, the FEF began to offer the undergraduate program in the evening with the same number of vacancies as the daytime program (50). In the same year the doctorate program was established.

The Trajectory of the Physical Education Faculty qualifies it as one of the best institutions of higher education with distinction in the national and international scenario. The graduate courses and research activities are recognized by the evaluation agencies and the work of the professors/researchers is a reference in several areas of knowledge, presenting constant growth indicators.

THE UNDER GRADUETE PROGRAM

. Licensure in Physical Education

To act in assistance, planning, execution and evaluation of the curricular components of the Physical Education on the basic education. He also will be able to elaborate programs of education of Physical Education for all series, levels or cycles, as well as contributing in institutions that develop educational programs. This professional will also act in the scientific research area focusing the education field.

. Bachelor in Physical Education

To act in assistance, planning, execution and evaluation of the of Physical Education programs in the fields of Sport, Leisure and the Physical Activities focusing to different social groups. It also will be able to act in the scientific research area and in different environments such as centers and sportive clubs, hospitals, ONGs (Non-governmental organization), companies, Hotels net, clinics and academy among others, which they would keep a strong relation with his formation area.

The Admission process occurs through an annual exam Vestibular - COMVEST (www.comvest.unicamp.br)

GRADUATE PROGRAM

The graduate program in Physical Education- master and doctorate level has carrying out its paper concerning to the scientific production aspect as well as the formation of qualified professionals to act in the superior education.

- Biodynamic of the Human Movement and Sport;

EXTENSION

The Coordination of the sport development - CODESP is responsible for the extension activities of FEF. Each semester it offers for the internal and external community of the Unicamp, programs of physical activities. It is also responsible for the specialization courses extension modality, whe is possible the construction, production and socialization of the knowledge that happens in the University. Through these activities approximately 2500 people are attended per semester, which implies that FEF is the greater offering of extension activities in the University.

DEPARTAMENTS

DCE - Department of Sport Sciences

Identifies as its objectives the education, researches and extension of the determinants, manifestations, content andresults of the sport.

Research Laboratories:

Aquatic Activities, Electromyography and Biomechanics of Posture and Electromyography Studies.

DEAFA - Department of Study of the Adapted Physical Activity

Studies the diversity of populations with specific characteristics: disabled people, athletes, sedentary individuals, menopaused women, middle-age men, Third Age, pregnancies, children and young from different social-economic class, aboriginal groups, agricultural populations and corporal image.

DEFH - Department of Physical Education and Humanities

Dedicated to teaching, studies and research in the field of Physical Education from the theoretical and methodological contributions of the humanities. Under this approach, the DEFH aims to consider the accumulated knowledge and develop new scientific contributions to ensure a solid academic background as well as increase their scope of social integration in contemporary dynamic, understanding and questioning of the different cultural values, in pursuit of the interests in our democratic society.

INFRASTRUCTURE

The Physical Education faculty is located in the Campus of Unicamp in the city of Campinas, Barão Geraldo district. It occupies an area of 93,000m², being 31,000m² of urbanized/grassed area, 20,000m² of natural area and 42,000m² of occupied areas for facilities: swimming pool, administrative building area, library, laboratories, gymnasium, classrooms, computer rooms, study rooms, teachers' rooms, congregation room. It also have a Sportive Center with: Open court, male and female dressings rooms, hall of dance, Cooper track, athletics track, soccer field, body building room, tennis court, gymnasium with 3 covered court and a gymnasium for practical of activities and research.
